P01 P01 a child that attends St John the Apostle OSHClub was involved in an altercation with another child at Afterschool Care on Friday 20th May 2022.

P01 was play fighting with another child and both children's behaviour were heightened since finishing school. There was no conflict between either child until they began to play fight, with both retaliating when they were hit.

The incident resulted in P01 being grabbed around his neck but no visible marks could be identified. The coordinator dealt with the incident and administered an icepack to P01 and spoke with both children and families. An incident report was written up.

P01's mum rang the Service on Monday morning 23/5/2022 and explained that she had taken P01 to be checked over by a doctor as she had noticed scratch marks on his back as well as what seemed to be a cut lip/lip swollen. Mum sent through pictures of these injuries to the Coordinator. On looking at these pictures it was not clear of any scratch marks to the back and the lip looked as though it has a bit of swelling.

The coordinator explained that at no point during the incident was any injuries to the lip/mouth area or the back discussed or observed or treated.

Staff and children were spoken too and no staff or children that observed the incident recalled any further incident or injuries. At no point did either child in the incident make mention of any further injuries.

P01 was back at the service on Monday 23rd May 2022.
