Asked by Mr James Milligan:

In relation to: Next Gen Energy Storage

MR MILLIGAN: And how much of the—is it \$25 million, that has been allocated for this program, is that correct?

Mr Rutledge: Yes.

MR MILLIGAN: How much of that is being used so far?

Mr Rutledge: Look, I think I will take, Mr Milligan, I will take the details of that. We will probably either get back to you during the hearing—

MR MILLIGAN: Sure.

Mr Rutledge: —or I will take it on notice.

MINISTER RATTENBURY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

\$6.9 million has been expensed to date under the Next Generation Energy Storage program. This includes payments made to battery installers, software developers for the Next Generation Energy Storage data platform, electrical inspections, and program administration.

A further \$3.9 million has been committed under contract, but is yet to be expensed.
