Dear Chair *James*

Thank you for your letters of 28 July and 4 August regarding the 2022-23 Budget Estimates Hearings. I am responding on behalf of the Government in my capacity as the Manager of Government Business.

I note in your correspondence that these hearings are to be conducted face to face in the Prince Edward Island Committee room at the Legislative Assembly.

I further note that the Committee has decided to depart from the previous practice of basing the hearings schedule on budget outputs.

Departing from the practice of using outputs means that all officials will be required to be in attendance for the entirety of each hearing, in some cases, from multiple Directorates.

As you are aware, the COVID-19 pandemic is still having a significant impact on our community with high case numbers in Canberra and many disruptions to workplaces as a result of COVID-related leave. This is also true for the ACT Public Service. In addition, the Chief Health Officer (CHO) has advised that the current epidemiological situation remaining uncertain. As a result, the CHO today extended the Public Health Emergency Declaration until 11.59pm on 30 September 2022.

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Your correspondence of 4 August 2022 lists the COVID-19 mechanisms that will be in place including social distancing, cleaning seats and desks and hand sanitiser; however, I would like further advice from the Committee on how social distancing will be managed, noting that potentially large numbers of people will be required to congregate at the Legislative Assembly and that the Committee room may not be able to accommodate the number of witnesses, leading to officials waiting in a less than ideal environment. The hearing process may be further hampered by the need to clean seats and desks as different witnesses are called to answer questions throughout any given hearing leading to a loss in the time available for questions to be asked and answered.

Whilst I believe that under the current environment the best approach would be to hold the hearings virtually, it is my understanding that the Committee rooms are currently being fit-out with Cisco WebEx boards. Given that this technology will be available, might I suggest a hybrid arrangement is put in place so that witnesses and officials have the choice to either attend in person or virtually depending on their personal preferences (to keep themselves and their families safe), and in line with the current arrangements for the ACT Public Service.

A hybrid arrangement will allow those that cannot attend hearings in person for reasons such as, isolating because of household contacts or being immuno-compromised, to still participate. It will also assist with limiting the number of people at the Legislative Assembly therefore reducing the risk of COVID-19 transmission. Adoption of such arrangements will also assist the Government, the Public Service and the Assembly discharge obligations under the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* to provide a safe workplace and take steps to mitigate risks for employees and those that they interact with.

In addition, to assist the Committee's scrutiny of the budget, enclosed is a copy of the budget outputs mapped against ministerial responsibility. This is similar to documents provided to assist previous committees in their consideration of the Appropriation bills. I also encourage the Committee revert to past practice and consider matters via the budget outputs. This will assist in orderly consideration of matters rather than possibly seeing questions jumping around outputs and/or different Directorates. To assist the Committee, Officials from Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) are available to advise which output best fits question topics of interest to the Committee.

As always, both my Office and Officials from the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate are available to assist the Committee.

Thank you for your consideration of this matter. I look forward to hearing from you.
