Second Public Hearing for EV inquiry

The [Standing Committee on Planning, Transport and City Services](#) will hold a second public hearing for its *Inquiry into electric vehicle (EV) adoption in the ACT* on Thursday, 18 May 2023.

The Committee will hear from Evoenergy, who is the owner and operator of the electricity network in the ACT.

The Committee Chair, Ms Jo Clay MLA, said: "Today's public hearing will be an opportunity to find out from Evoenergy how the Territory's electricity network and infrastructure will need to adapt to accommodate an uptake in EVs."
