Inquiry into Annual and Financial Reports 2022-2023 **ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE**

Reference: Hearing on 20 November 2023, Annual Report of Transport Canberra and City Services

In relation to: Storm Water improvements Hall

Minister, there seems to be no mention of stormwater improvements to the Village of Hall in the TCCS annual report.

1. When will the village of Hall see an actual change to their stormwater drainage issues?
2. How much more community consultation, feasibility studies and design work need to be conducted for work to begin?
3. How much of the allocated money in the 23/24 ACT budget will be used for Hall?
4. How much has the Government spent on laneway maintenance and repairs in the last 12 months?

Minister Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

1. Detailed design is currently underway and expected to be complete this financial year. The finalisation of design is necessary before construction can commence. TCCS will seek opportunity to secure matched funding from the Australian Government following completion of the detailed design stage.
2. Community consultation will be carried out as part of the detailed design stage. The development of the detailed design will occur this financial year.
3. Capital funding of \$337,000 has been allocated to the Hall Village stormwater detailed design project. This project is half funded by the Commonwealth's Disaster Ready Fund.
4. Roads ACT has funded \$10,800 including GST on laneway maintenance (incl. drainage / stormwater) in Hall in the last 12 months.
