



Terms of Reference

Inquiry into the Secure Local Jobs Code

The Committee will inquire into and report on the effectiveness and operation of the Secure Local Jobs Code, including:

- a) whether the Code is achieving its objectives, including the appropriateness of the exclusion of some industries;
- b) whether the Code delivers value for money;
- c) the adequacy of any performance and evaluation frameworks for the Code;
- d) the extent to which the Code supports local jobs (including subcontractors and apprentices) and small and medium sized enterprise (including in supply chains and the not-for-profit sector);
- e) the administrative and compliance burden placed on tenderers, and whether this imposes barriers to participation;
- f) the effectiveness of the Code's certification, auditing, reporting, and compliance arrangements;
- g) the appropriateness of the role, composition, and operation of the Secure Local Jobs Advisory Council;
- h) the interaction between the Secure Local Jobs Code Registrar and other parties to procurement; and
- i) any other related matter.
