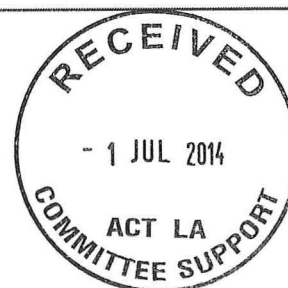

**ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE
DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS**

Asked by Brendan Smyth on 24 June 2014: Mr Jim Corrigan, Executive-Director took on notice the following question:

Ref: Hansard Transcript, Select Committee on Estimates, 24 June 2014 page 50

What proportion of DAs go slightly over the 45 day statutory timeframe?

Minister Corbell, MLA, for the Environment and Sustainable Development: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

In this case the term 'slightly over' has been taken to mean between 46 to 60 days for determination of the Development Application (DA).

Of the 1105 DAs determined in the period 1 July 2013 to 23 June 2014, 338 DAs took more than 45 days to decide. Of these, 105 DAs took between 46 to 60 days to determine. The 105 DAs represent 9.5% of the DAs determined in the period.
