Inquiry into referred 2015–16 Annual and Financial Reports ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE 27 February 2017

Asked by MR COE:

In relation to: public interest disclosures

1. Does the figure of twelve PIDs in 2015-16 include any anonymous disclosures?
2. What analysis has been done of the PIDs to determine if there are any common factors or particular areas of concern?
3. How many PIDs have been received to date in 2016-17?
 - a. Were any of the PIDs received in this financial year anonymous disclosures?
4. Have any PIDs been received regarding the handling of the departure of executives from the former Territory and Municipal Services Directorate?

CHIEF MINISTER: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

1. Of the twelve PIDS two were anonymous.
2. The limited number of PIDs indicates complaints are spread evenly across directorates with no common factors or particular areas of concern.
3. Thirteen PIDs have been received to date in 2016-17, with seven being anonymous.
4. No PIDs have been received regarding the departure of executives from the former Territory and Municipal Services Directorate.
