ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Ms Cheyne: To ask the Minister for Transport

Question on Notice by Tara Cheyne, in connection with light rail additional services and safety infrastructure enhancements, Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate, considered in hearings of 2 March 2020:

1. Will any funding be allocated to the installation of bicycle storage cages along the light rail stage one route {between Gungahlin and Civic}?
2. Has Transport Canberra and City Services considered the installation of bicycle storage cages along the light rail stage one route {between Gungahlin and Civic}?

Minister Chris Steel: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

1. Well Station Road Park and Ride, once built, will have bike and ride hoops, there will be bike hoops installed on the corner of Morisset and Flemington Roads located across the road from the future Mitchell Light Rail stop. There are currently bike parking rails located at all stops on the light rail alignment in addition to an existing bike cage at the Nullarbor Avenue stop. We are considering bike cages along the light rail stage one route between Gungahlin and the City.
2. Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) continues to monitor the usage of existing bike parking along the light rail stage one route between Gungahlin and Civic and has considered the installation of additional bike cages to provide customers with more secure options for customers to ride to the light rail. In line with this objective, TCCS installed eight bike racks under shelter and within CCTV coverage at the Gungahlin light rail stop and bus interchange in November 2019.
