### New inquiry into Specialist Disability Accommodation service delivery through Housing ACT

The Standing Committee on Public Accounts and Administration has announced it will be undertaking an inquiry into Specialist Disability Accommodation service delivery through Housing ACT, following a referral from the Assembly on 3 December 2025.

‘Housing ACT used to be registered to provide Specialist Disability Accommodation via a NDIS funded program, however this registration has been allowed to lapse,’ said Mr Milligan, Committee Chair.

‘The relationship between the NDIS, Housing ACT, community service providers, and tenants is a complex one, and this inquiry intends to scrutinise the sources of funding and the effectiveness of delivery of specialist accommodation.’
