Ms Sophie Clements took on notice the following question(s):

MR EMERSON: Okay. And there was a mini ramp near the pool there, in Dickson, that has disappeared. Do you know when and why that disappeared? Noting that it just disappeared.

Ms Clement: Yes, I do not have the details on that. So we would have to take that on notice.

MR EMERSON: Okay. Thanks, chair.

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

There was a concrete mini ramp located on Dickson Section 72 Block 14. As the asset was not located on public unleased land, records of the mini ramp are not on the City Presentation asset register.

This site was the Majura Community Centre and the Majura Occasional Care Centre in the 1990's and is now Northside Community Services. The mini ramp was one of several built in the 1990's around Canberra including at Campbell, Telopea Park, Stirling and Holt.

Based on aerial records, the mini ramp was removed between 2006 and 2009. CED do not hold any records with information on the removal

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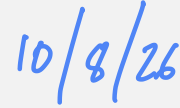
