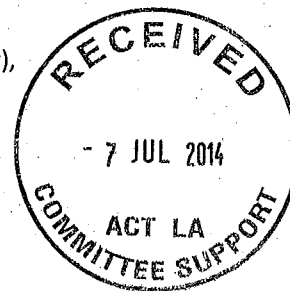

Mr STEVE DOSZPOT, MLA: To ask the Minister for Ageing

In relation to: ACT Strategic Plan for Positive Ageing 2012 – 2014
Strategic Priority 6 – Transport and Mobility
Objective 14 – Assist older Canberrans to transition from driving

1. One of the performance indicators for this objective is to increase the number of hits on the COTA ACT live drive website. What increase has been made in this financial year?
2. How does this compare to last financial year?

MINISTER RATTENBURY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. The LiveDrive website has been renamed Seniors Moving Safely: <http://seniorsmovingsafely.org.au>. This website is about road safety for older people and aims to provide useful information, increase awareness of road safety issues, and help older Canberrans to be safer as a driver, pedestrian, or other road user.

The number of unique visitors on the website from 1 July 2013 to 26 June 2014 was 4,749 (with 58,697 recorded hits).
2. In 2012-13 there were 4,247 unique visitors (and 52,397 recorded hits). This is a 11.8% increase in unique visitors and an 12% increase in recorded hits.
