In relation to: Florey Oval

- 1. When will consultation with the school community regarding plans for the Florey oval begin?
- 2. Will the oval be split into two for school use and community use?
- 3. How much funding will be provided for the rehabilitation of the oval?
 - a. Will this funding be split up between the two sides should the oval be split?
 - b. If so, how much funding will each side be receiving?
- 4. Will the addition of more off-street parking be considered?
 - a. Will the addition of a pavilion be considered?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. Consultation is already underway between relevant Directorates to improve school access to green space adjacent to Florey Primary School.
- 2-4. The ACT Government is aware of community interest in improvements to the Florey Oval which is currently a dryland (non-irrigated) oval suitable for informal community use. No specific budget allocation has been made for this purpose and the nature and cost of improvements is subject to future consideration and consultation.
