ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Elizabeth Kikkert MLA: To ask the Attorney-General

Ref: Budget Outlook, p. 181; Budget Statement D, p. 7; output class 2.1

In relation to: offenders at large

1. How many offenders who had their parole or community corrections order cancelled and a warrant subsequently issued for their arrest remotely (i.e., over the phone or video call) are at large?
2. What is each at—large offender charged with, and how long has each been at large?
3. Of the offenders referenced in the answer to Question on Notice 787 (dated 7 June 2022), how many of these have been arrested, and how many are still at large?

SHANE RATTENBURY MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

As at 7 September 2022:

1. How many offenders who had their parole or community corrections order cancelled and a warrant subsequently issued for their arrest remotely (i.e., over the phone or video call) are at large?

Of the offenders who have had their order cancelled remotely, there are seven currently at large.

2. What is each at—large offender charged with, and how long has each been at large?


Offender	Period at large	Charge
1	715 days	Knowingly concerned burglary and knowingly concerned theft x2
2	447 days	Fail to appear after bail undertaking; fail to stop motor vehicle for police; drive motor vehicle with alcohol in blood or breath; drive while disqualified
3	421 days	Damage property over \$1000
4	219 days	Robbery with actual violence armed/in company/wounded/used personal violence; contravene FVO

5	181 days	Drive while disqualified x4; Fail to stop motor vehicle for police; aggravated furious/reckless/dangerous driving; ride/drive motor vehicle without consent; fail to appear after bail undertaking; furious/reckless/dangerous driving x2; other person not give particulars of driver
6	27 days	Aggravated furious/reckless/dangerous driving; drive while disqualified x2
7	1 day	Arson building/vehicle

3. Of the offenders referenced in the answer to Question on Notice 787 (dated 7 June 2022), how many of these have been arrested, and how many are still at large?

Of the offenders referenced in QON 787, all four remain at large.
