Asked by Mr Jonathan Davis MLA on 12 April 2023: Mr Shane Rattenbury MLA took on notice the following question:

### In relation to: Energy Prices in the ACT

"THE CHAIR: Thank you, Ms Lawder. I have got a supplementary on that, minister. A lot of the evidence you provided about what is impacting our energy prices are national and global. Do we have any evidence on how our energy prices in the ACT compare and contrast to other states and territories?

*Mr* Rattenbury: We do have data on that. I can provide a detailed table to the committee on notice, if you wish."

Mr Shane Rattenbury MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

Table 1 shows a comparison of electricity prices between National Electricity Market (NEM) states and the ACT based on the current Default Market Offer (DMO) for 2022-23, or its jurisdictional equivalent.

A comparison of DMOs for the 2023-24 period is also provided where that information is available.

The Standing Offer for the ACT for 2023-24 is prepared by the Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission (ICRC) but will not be available until June 2023.
