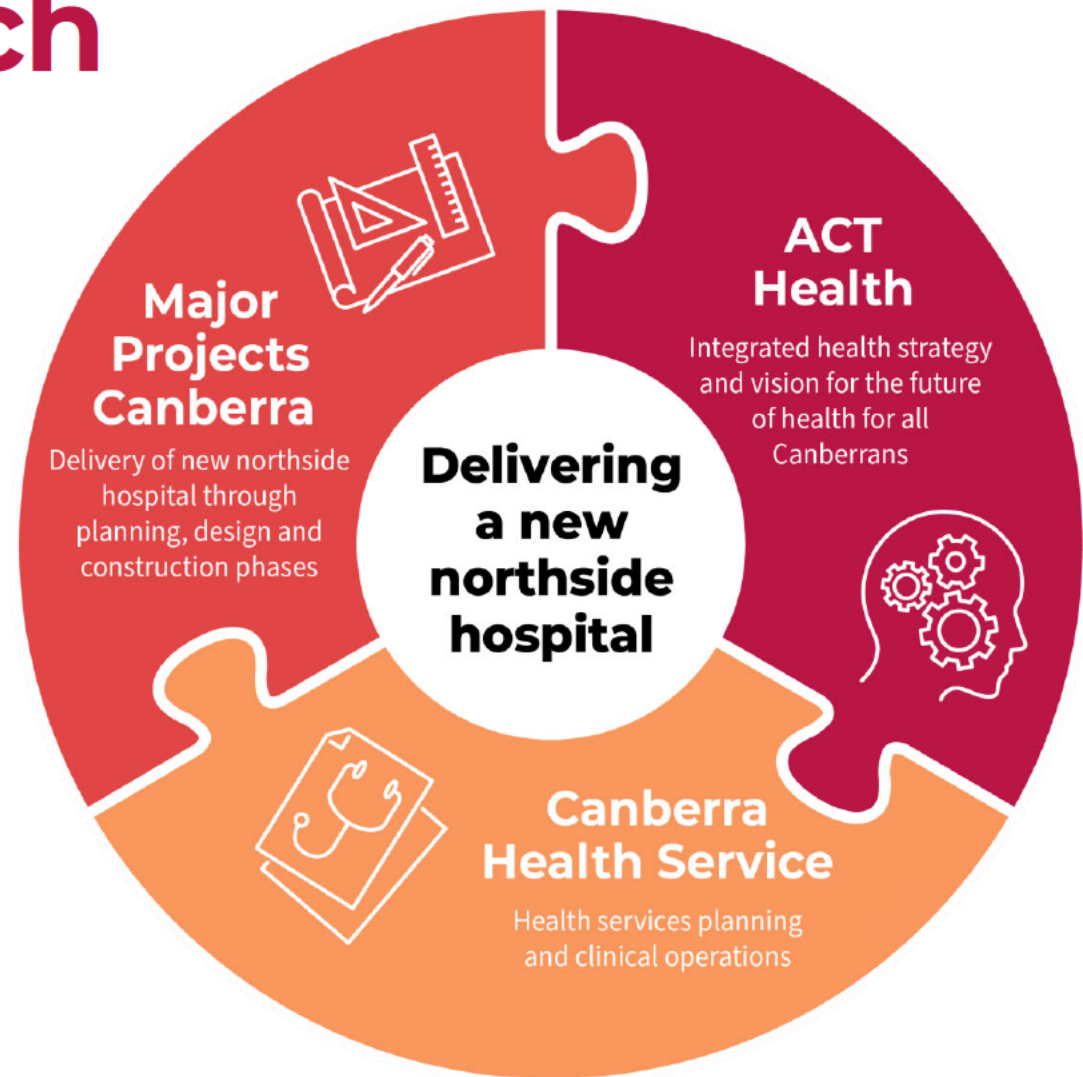

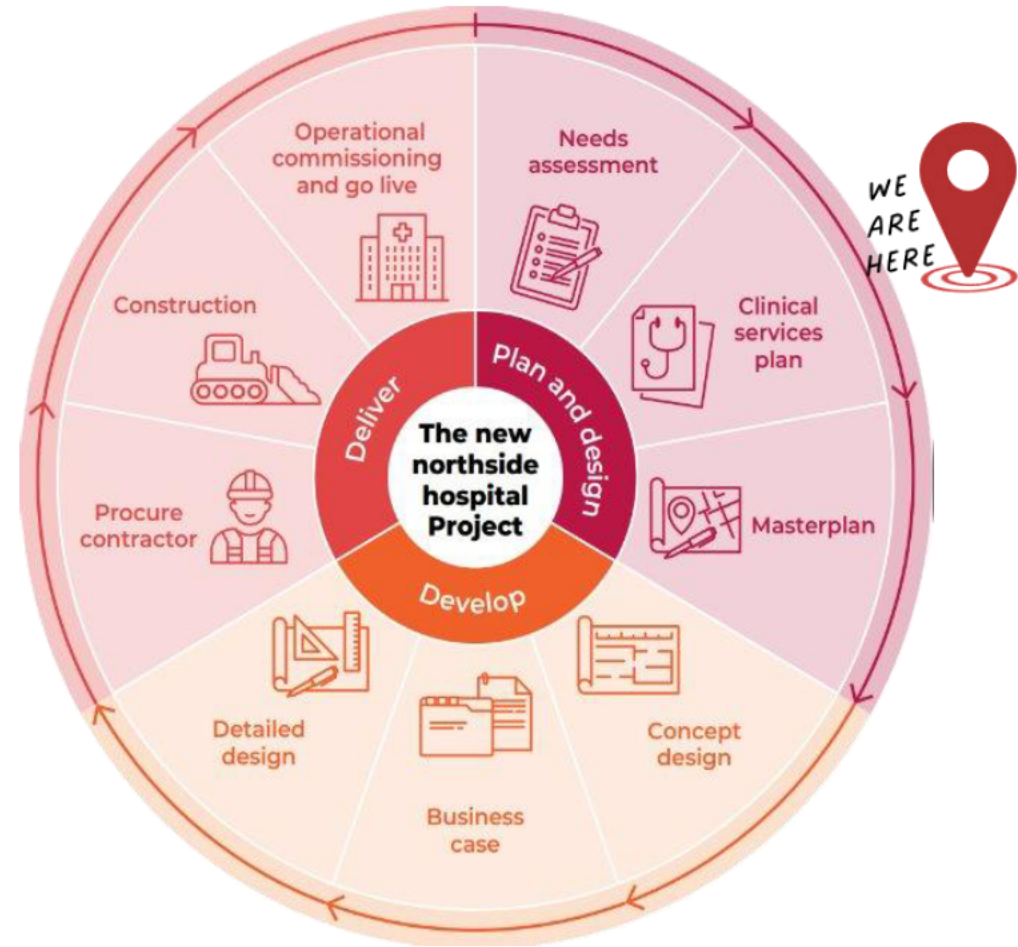


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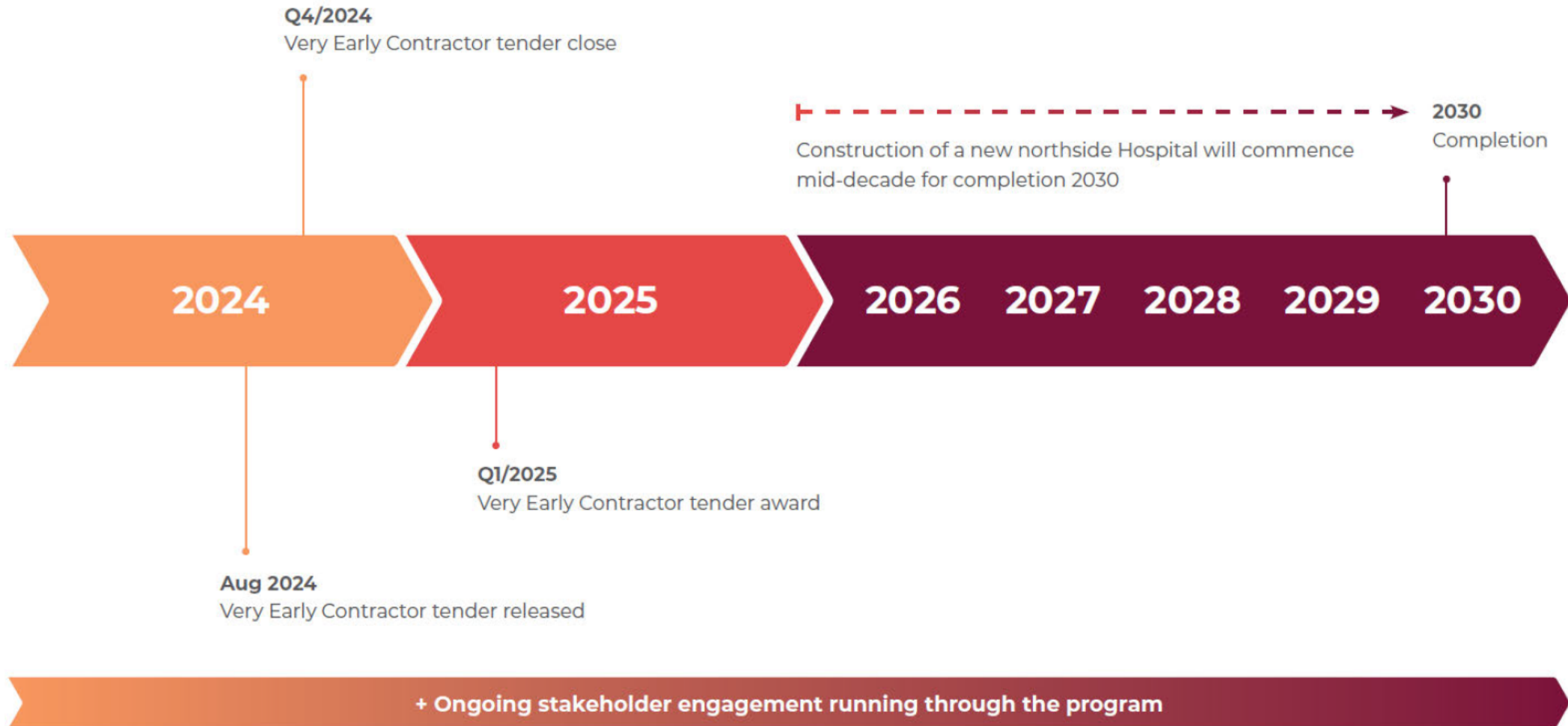
Phases - delivering a new hospital

The Cottage Update

Early planning for the new hospital has started with the expected announcement next week of the preferred designer and relocation of the Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) Cottage.

It will be announced that this service will be moving to Lyons and benefit from a new purpose-built facility in a location that will be central to the broader ACT community.

The design for the new facility is the first step with the relocation of The Cottage not expected until mid 2026 to make way for site preparation for the new northside hospital.

The Cottage is being relocated presents an opportunity to ensure these services are in the right location, are functional for clinicians, welcoming for patients and environmentally sustainable.
