According to the Pegasus report, “In nominal terms, revenue collected from gambling taxes is steadily increasing from an expected outcome of around \$88 million in 2025-26 to \$93.6 million in 2029-30 at the end of the forward estimates.” Do these forecasts assume no new gambling harm reduction reforms?
