MS HUNTER : Asked the Minister for Tourism, Sport and Recreation

“You may need to take these ones on notice too as they may be slightly out of your directorate. In 2010-11 the environment and sustainability commissioner investigated a proposal around ecotourism ventures in Tidbinbilla and recommended that a comprehensive policy for commercial operations on land zoned as national parks be developed. The first question is: what was the government’s response to that recommendation and is the policy being developed?”

Mr Hill: I will take that on notice.”

MR BARR: The answer to the Member’s question is as follows:

The Territory and Municipal Services (TAMS) Directorate has advised that the Government agreed to the Commissioner’s recommendation. The recommendation is consistent with policies already in place in the Namadgi National Park Plan of Management 2010. As such, policies in the Namadgi Plan of management have already been incorporated into the Tidbinbilla revised draft Plan of Management.
