Inquiry into referred 2017–18 Annual and Financial Reports ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE Monday, 12 November 2018



Asked by MS CHEYNE MLA:

In relation to:

MS CHEYNE: Just—I think you might have to take it on notice based on previous responses, Mr Salisbury, but I think it would be helpful for context to know for the precincts that we have been focusing on how many commercial properties there are in each precinct. And then I think the chair mentioned we get the share—or I did, I think.

Could we get the share in Braddon but could we get it, in all of those precincts that we have been talking about, about how many have had a valuation adjustment? And then for broader context, could I at least get a sense of how many commercial properties there are in the ACT total? Then how many across all of the ACT have had valuation adjustments?

Ms Vroombout: So I can answer the first part of that last question.

MS CHEYNE: Sure.

Ms Vroombout: So there are 6,146 commercial properties in the ACT.

MS CHEYNE: 6,000—

Ms Vroombout: 146.

MS CHEYNE: Okay.

Ms Vroombout: So that is in 2018.

MS CHEYNE: Okay. All right. Well, that is one less question on notice.

Treasurer: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

Of the 6,146 commercial properties in the ACT, 311 were reviewed and values adjusted as required.

The following table outlines the number of commercial properties and those reviewed in Braddon, City, Phillip and Fyshwick precincts:
