In relation to: Belconnen Skate park

1. Regarding the 2020 election promise install a new half-pipe at Belconnen Skate Park, is the funding for this in the budget?
 - a. If so, under what line item is this funding included?
 - i. How much funding will there be for the new half-pipe?
 - ii. When will the installation or construction of the half-pipe take place?
 - iii. When will this be complete?
 - iv. Will there be a public consultation phase?
 - b. If not, why has the Government not funded this commitment?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member’s question is as follows:–

1. Yes.
 - a. The funding is included in the 2020-21 Budget Statement H on page 43, line 4. The funding is provided through the Commonwealth Local Roads and Community Infrastructure program.
 - i. \$0.5m.
 - ii. The design and installation/construction of the half pipe will commence in mid-2021.
 - iii. Completion is anticipated by December 2021.
 - iv. Targeted consultation will be undertaken with the ACT skateboard community through the Canberra Skateboard Association.
