In relation to: Active and Public Transport % Road Budget

The 2020 Transport Strategy states that we are rebalancing investment towards public transport, cycling and walking. But it's hard to see exactly how much money is spent on public and active travel compared to how much is spent on roads.

1. What was the total community path maintenance expenditure for each of the past 2 financial years?
2. What is the budgeted community path maintenance expenditure for 2020/21?
3. Can you report on this clearly in the next annual report?

**Chris Steel MLA:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Community path maintenance expenditure in 2018-19 and 2019-20.

2018-19	2019-20
\$4.7m	\$4.7m

2. Community path maintenance budget in 2020-21.

2020-21
\$6.4m

3. The community path maintenance budget is captured against Output Class 2.1: Roads and Infrastructure. The performance of TCCS in meeting this output class is measured through associated accountability indicators. TCCS is currently reviewing the existing accountability indicators.
