In relation to:

- 1. Is the ACT Government prepared for the upcoming fire season?
- 2. Are all relevant positions in teams that deal with fire preparedness filled?
- 3. How is EPSDD implementing the Union Encouragement Policy?

Minister Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- The ACT Parks and Conservation Service was well prepared for the 2021-22 Bushfire Season which commenced on 1 November 2021 and concluded on 16 March 2022. Seasonal firefighters had commenced and completed their basic training, staff rosters were prepared and all pre-season firefighting equipment and asset maintenance had been completed. All fuel management contracts were in place.
- 2. All relevant operational and planning roles within the ACT Parks and Conservation Fire Unit were filled.
- 3. The Union Encouragement Policy has been (and will continue to be) proactively communicated to EPSDD staff through regular internal communications channels (written and verbal) and is also published via the ACTPS Employment Portal and EPSDD's Intranet. The Policy is promoted at induction sessions for new employees and Executives, Managers and Supervisors have been made aware (with reminders from time to time) of their individual obligations under the Policy.
