- 1) What is the FTE of CHS staff that are on leave or have leave approved for more than 30 days, broken down by classification e.g. RN1, RN2, RMO1, RMO2 etc...?
- 2) What is the FTE of CHS staff that are on leave or have approved leave for more than 7 days?
- 3) How much has been paid by CHS for staff settlements in disputes and terminations?

MINISTER STEPHEN-SMITH MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: —



There are 47 different types/categories of leave for Canberra Health Services' (CHS) staff. To obtain the information for all CHS staff that are on leave or have leave approved as well as a break down by classification as requested, would be an unreasonable diversion of resources. CHS is able to provide advice for the last financial year 2021-22, the charts below show the type and hours of leave taken (noting that "other leave" includes COVID leave). In the last financial year 143,799 instances of leave were processed, noting that there are many instances where multiple leave applications are processed for the same employee.


#### All CHS Staff




## **Nursing Staff**




# **Medical Officers**




# **Administrative Officers**
