### ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

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**Elizabeth Lee MLA:** To ask the Cultural Facilities Corporation:

1. In relation to the recruitment process for the current Cultural Facilities Corporation (CFC) Chief of Staff, please provide:
  - a) Recruitment process evaluation reports for all applicants;
  - b) Deidentified resumes of all applicants;
  - c) All internal and external correspondence to and from CFC regarding the recruitment process;
  - d) All documentation related to the transition of this position from temporary to permanent.

**Tara Cheyne MLA:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The Cultural Facilities Corporation (CFC), an independent body with a governing board, advises:

- a) Meaningful copies of the recruitment process evaluation reports are not possible after redactions have been made to protect personal information and protect the individual's right to privacy. The CFC has received a request for similar information under Freedom of Information provisions and the CFC is currently assessing the request in accordance with the requirements of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016*.
- b) Meaningful copies of the resumes are not possible after redactions have been made to protect personal information and protect the individual's right to privacy. The CFC has received a request for similar information under Freedom of Information provisions and the CFC is currently assessing the request in accordance with the requirements of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016*.
- c) Internal and external correspondence relating to the Chief of Staff recruitment process is at Attachment A. Redactions have been made to protect personal information and protect the individual's right to privacy. Emailed attachments have not been included where meaningful copies are not possible after redactions have been made to protect personal information and protect the individual's right to privacy. The CFC has received a request for similar information under Freedom of Information provisions and the CFC is currently assessing the request in accordance with the requirements of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016*.
- d) The Chief of Staff position was created, advertised, and filled as a permanent position.
