- 1. The Standing Committee on Education and Community Inclusion resolves to inquire into and report on the future of ACT school infrastructure, with particular reference to:
  - a) access to safe and healthy schools, including distance (travel to school);
  - b) age-appropriate learning and recreation spaces;
  - c) consideration of the external environment, including climate awareness;
  - d) the learning interactions between teachers, spaces and pedagogy, including scheduling/timetabling of access to spaces;
  - e) cross-cultural impact;
  - f) context for students from varying income backgrounds (class analysis);
  - g) use of technology;
  - h) optimal school size;
  - i) synergies with the wider community; and,
  - j) long-term planning and demographic change.
