In relation to: Behaviour Management Framework Review

DR PATERSON: That is the one that I am most interested in, the behaviour management framework. Can you speak more about—so the review has been undertaken and there has been recommendations for improvements from that review. Is that how it has worked?

MS BENDAS: So, we have taken an in-house review also of the behaviour management framework and looking at best practice but also what other jurisdictions are using in regards to the behaviour management frameworks and strategies in other youth detention centres within Australia. So, that review has commenced and we are working closely with New South Wales. Who we are using, and I would have to take on notice the name.

MINISTER DAVIDSON: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The behaviour management model which will be adapted at Bimberi Youth Justice Centre is Positive Behaviour Interventions and Support (PBIS).
