In relation to: p.101-102. of Uncorrected Proof Transcript:

Did anything change in the appropriation between when, say, this committee was advised that there would be a supplementary appropriation and whether we could have these hearings today, which was, my recollection, 13 December—did anything change between then and when the appropriation bill was presented to change the projected appropriation for Health which we are now discussing, which is slightly south of \$60 million?

No changes were made to the funding profile from the notice of hearings made on 23 December 2019 and the appropriation bill being presented in assembly on 13 February 2020.
