Asked by Mr Jeremy Hanson MLA: To ask the Minister for Police and Emergency Services:

In relation to: **Staffing**

Ref EBT 1 - ACT Policing

1. What is the average full time equivalent (FTE) police staff covered by the service agreement in ACT Policing in the following categories calculated by the same methodology of the Productivity Commission ROGS reporting:
 - a. Sworn
 - b. Unsworn
 - c. Other

in each of the years 2015-16 to 2019-20?

2. What was the increase in FTE in each of those categories in each of these years in above?
3. What is the number of operational police staff covered by the service agreement in ACT Policing as calculated by the same methodology of the Productivity Commission ROGS reporting in each of the years 2015-16 to 2019-20?

Mick Gentleman MLA: I am advised that the answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

ROGS data is calculated utilising Actual FTE (at 30 June of each financial year) rather than Average FTE. Information in relation to staffing profiles are publicly available through the annual reports for ACT Policing. Please note that prior to the 2017-18 financial year, ACT Policing reported Actual FTE as at 30 June in its Annual Report. In answering this question, ACT Policing has provided below Actual FTE to align with the request for ROGS calculated data.
