## <u>Tasmanian Election Update - Recommendation</u>

At the time of this committee hearing closing for Submissions ,the Tasmanian Election was held on the Saturday  $1^{st}$  May 2021. What was interesting was the seat of Clark which has now elected an independent for the first time since the number of seats in the house of assembly was reduced from 35 members to 25 in 1998.

I note that the ballot paper for Clark included two independents, both had their own column. How? According to the Tasmanian Candidate Information Booklet<sup>2</sup>:

## **Group candidate(s)**

A valid nomination for one or more candidates to appear in a group not under a heading of a registered party requires:

- » at least 100 nominators (electors within the division); and
- » the details, signature and a statement of consent of each candidate

So for an independent to get their own column they need 100 elector signatures from the electorate. Independents having their own distinct column played a factor here and should be afforded to independents here in the ACT. Though the high amount of signatures required is an issue. As I have stated in my submission this should be reduced for all Independents. Also in the Information booklet, candidates only need 10 signatures for the up-grouped column.
