HRPerformance aims to streamline the employee appraisal process and align individual team goals with the Office's capability framework and strategic plan. The system is now available for the 2022-2023 performance and development cycle.

Parliamentary Portal

- Committees module to assist with the administration of committees
- Questions module to members and support to create and submit questions and answers, support staff to manage
- Online searchable questions database that contains all Assembly Questions on Notice from the 10th Assembly
- E-Petitions module to assist with the administration of electronic and paper petitions
- E-Petitions web pages that allow members of the public to set up or sign a petition
- Broadcasting module to replace the bespoke Assembly on Demand system with a commercial offthe-shelf solution

Future releases

- The remaining work currently underway is the Committee web pages which includes:
 - The ability to allow online submissions
 - O Committee, inquiry and hearing data to be instantly updated on the website as soon as it is entered into the portal.
 - Due to be complete by the end of 2022
- Potential future work subject to budget considerations includes streamlined and more automated solutions for Hansard and Assembly papers.
