Reference: Hearing on 31 October 2022, Annual Report of Transport Canberra and City Services

In relation to: TCCS emissions reduction reporting

The TCCS Strategic Plan 2021-2024, which was launched Sept 2021, identified measures for TCCS including "Six monthly reporting against the ACT Climate Change strategy and performance data in the TCCS Annual Report, Ecological and Sustainable Development section."

- (1) Why was this reporting not included in the 21-22 Annual Report?
- (2) When will six monthly reporting begin?
- (3) What will be included in the six-monthly reporting which does not form part of an Annual Report?
- (4) Will this be six monthly reporting be published?

CHRIS STEEL MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

- (1) The relevant goal and measure under the TCCS Strategic Plan 2021-2024 was set to align with whole of government internal reporting to the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) against the ACT Climate Change Strategy. This information wasn't included in the TCCS Annual Report because it is already reported annually through the *Minister's Annual Report under the Climate Change and Greenhouse Gas Reduction Act 2010*, which is publicly available.
- (2) TCCS is already report to CMTEDD against the ACT Climate Change Strategy on a quarterly basis.

- (3) Reporting against the Climate Change Strategy is provided in the *Minister's Annual Report under the Climate Change and Greenhouse Gas Reduction Act 2010*.
- (4) Reporting against the Climate Change Strategy is provided in the *Minister's Annual Report under the Climate Change and Greenhouse Gas Reduction Act 2010*.
