DR PATERSON: And is there any specific community that you are seeing as in more need than others?

Ms Andrevski: I would have to check, and I would really happy to have a look and let you know if you are interested.

DR PATERSON: Yeah, great. If there is anything, a story to tell, that we would be interested.

Ms Andrevski: Yeah, definitely. And we do work very closely with the Red Cross through their Humanitarian Settlement Program, so where they are receiving—you know, supporting migrant families who have come, you know, together or at the same time from a particular country that might sort of skew things a little, but I am really happy to have a look at that and let you know.

DR PATERSON: Yeah, great.

THE CHAIR: Great, thank you. So, just to be clear, that sounds like a question on notice?

Ms Andrevski: Yes, I am happy to take that as a question on notice.
