Asked by Mr Peter Cain MLA on 20 November 2023: Mr Ben McHugh took on notice the following question(s):

Reference: Hansard proof transcript 20 November 2023, pages 76 and 77

In relation to: MyWay upgrade cost

MR CAIN: Minister, just finally, what is the expected cost of this whole new payment system?

Mr Steel: I think we have released the contract on the contracts register with the cost and announced cost. I am happy to hand over to Ben McHugh.

MR CAIN: Which is what?

Mr McHugh: I would not have the exact dollar figure at hand. The contract is in two parts. One is for the development and implementation of the new system, and the second phase is the operations of that contract for 10 years beyond that point. That detail is published and available. We can also provide those numbers on notice.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The total contract value is \$64 million, made up of \$28 million for the development and implementation of the new system, and \$36 million for the second phase of operations over ten years. All figures are GST inclusive.
