MR CAIN: Thank you. Look, I do note that on page 46 of your Annual Report, that one assessment was undertaken by the senior executive responsible for business integrity risk. And that was referred to the Integrity Commissioner. Can you outline the situation and why it was referred? I mentioned page 46—

Ms Geraghty: Yes. No, I have the reference. I do not have that answer. But I know that it is still with the Integrity Commission.

MR CAIN: Right. So will you take on notice my actual question?

Ms Geraghty: I can.

Mr Andrew Barr MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

In April 2022, Major Projects Canberra (MPC) became aware of a matter involving a contractor and their management of invoices. Following an investigation, the matter has been referred to the ACT Integrity Commission. MPC is awaiting further advice from the ACT Integrity Commission.
