P01 P01 was having afternoon tea at the table. P01 was given cream cheese on a corn thin for afternoon tea accidentally by an educator (who progressed from being a casual Educator to permanent Educator that week). P01 consumed 2 tiny bites of corn thin. P01 is allergic to dairy products. P01's food was taken away by the other permanent Educator. P01 was asked to drink water and then her parents were notified immediately about it via phone call. Parent advised to monitor her closely and if she shows any signs of symptoms administer antihistamine as per the risk minimization plan and inform parents immediately. However, there was no reactions noticed, P01 was playful and engaged in her normal activities as usual. No medications were administered at the Centre. P01 did not demonstrate any signs of reaction or distress, but the educators kept monitoring her condition until she went home in the afternoon.

Steps been taken to prevent or minimise this type of incident in the future:

- The educators who were in the room at that time were alerted about P01's dietary requirements, her medical condition and the incident that occurred and to monitor her closely until she went home.
- As a reflection, we ordered specific RED colored bowls for the chef to serve children with dietary requirements each day.
- A follow up call was done over the weekend to parents to check on P01. Parent was very appreciative and grateful for checking in P01. Mum mentioned as a precaution they seeked doctor's advice and the doctor prescribed some medication as a precaution and that P01 was doing fine and did not have any symptoms and just had tiny cough.
- All educators have been alerted to ensure the dietary requirements are followed strictly with the use of the app before serving food.
- Casual educators are not permitted to serve food.
- Thorough induction will be conducted again to the Educator who served the food to P01.
- Our Chef will continue to use the labels and new red colored bowls to children with dietary requirements.
