1. Were adjoining lessees of the former Braddon Bowls Club (Block 16 Section 25 Braddon) notified that DPA-07 had been released for public comment?
2. Can you provide a map showing which lessees were notified?
3. What other forms of publication were used to notify the public that DPA-07 had been released?

**Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:**

(1) I am advised by the Territory Planning Authority (TPA) that yes, as part of the public notification process, adjoining lessees were notified directly of the release of the draft plan amendment for public consultation.

(2) I am advised by the Territory Planning Authority (TPA) that a map identifying individual lessees to be contacted via mailout is not included in the published consultation material available on the ACT Government Planning website however is provided at [Attachment A](#) for the information of the Committee.

(3) I am advised by the Territory Planning Authority (TPA) that Draft Plan Amendment 07 was publicly notified through the ACT Government Planning website, where the draft plan amendment, supporting documentation and information on how to make a submission were published. Public consultation was undertaken for the statutory consultation period in accordance with the *Planning Act 2023*. Members of the public were invited to make written submissions during the consultation period.
