Funding paid by the Building and Construction Industry Training Fund Authority (TFA) to the Canberra Institute of Technology for the past three financial years totals as follows:

FY 2023/24 \$479,045

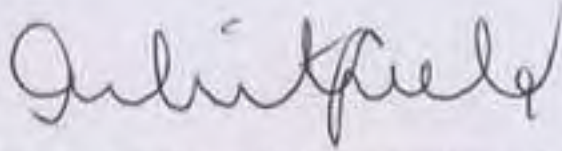
FY 2024/25 \$332,115

FY 2025/26 \$98,226

This funding provided to CIT covers part of the fees for eligible students who have completed and passed their training. This reduces the cost of training for those who qualify for TFA rebates.
